

What to Bring

- 1 suitcase and one carry-on with luggage tag (with your name on it)
- Lunch for first day of travel (we will not be stopping at a restaurant)
- Pillow and blanket for bus
- Sleeping Bag
- 2B Alive! tour shirts
- Black pants/shorts (to be worn by everyone at worship sites)
- Music (musicians)
- Bathing suit
- Sunscreen and insect repellent
- Sunglasses/hat
- Bus activities (ie: book(s), “travel-size” games, etc), pen/pencils
- Snacks for the bus and worksites
- Toiletries/ Beach towel (also to be used as shower towel)/washrag
- Watch with an alarm (or travel clock)
- Flashlight
- Light jacket or sweatshirt
- Spending cash (recommended \$100-\$150 for out-of-pocket meals and basic souvenirs)
- Camera
- Clothes (please wear respectable clothes, ie. no alcohol/drug or edgy logos, no short-shorts and no low-low cut tanks – please!)
- Work clothes:
 - Don’t expect to wear anything more than once! Work clothes should include:
 - Respectable t-shirts;
 - Shorts and/or jeans;
 - Long-sleeve shirt and jeans (in case you end up working with insulation);
 - Sturdy, closed-toe shoes (don’t forget socks!);
 - Bandana, head-band and/or hat
- Work-site items:
 - Backpack and/or tool belt
 - Tools (Please label any tools you bring. The more tools we bring the more tools accessible for everyone.)
 - Hammer;
 - Nail apron;
 - Marking pencil;
 - Measuring tape;
 - Utility knife;
 - Cordless electric drill (if you have one) and bits;
 - Paintbrushes
 - Ask Glenn about other tools
 - Face masks;
 - 2 good pairs of work gloves (we recommend those that will “breathe”);
 - Knee pads (recommended but not required);
 - Small personal first-aid kit consisting of Band-Aids, Neosporin, tweezers, etc;
 - Snacks (we will be providing some snacks, but if you know you’ll need more, you’ll want to come prepared);
 - Water bottle
- Rain gear (poncho)
- Recommend bringing an individual soft insulated lunch bag (with name on it);
- DVDs: Only bring movies appropriate for a church youth group. This includes G, PG, and approved PG-13 movies. Glenn and Brad have total veto power on all movies! Get pre-approved otherwise you’ll have to leave them at the church!
- iPod and iTravel if you’d like to share your music along the way. However, personal movie viewers are not permitted.
- Necessary medications
